2. **Location** Littleton Sailing Club, Littleton Ln, Shepperton TW17 0NF
3. **Entry and Eligibility**
Entry is open to all MYA members and to members of foreign clubs affiliated to a Delegated National Member of IRSA. Preferably, enter directly on-line via the MYA Racing Calendar. The final closing date for receipt of entries is 23.00hrs May 29th 2026. It would be helpful if those who intend to race advise the above at an earlier date. If you would like to come and join us and help create some fun, do not leave your entry to the last minute - **ENTER NOW!**
4. **Entry Fees** - Event entry fees are £12.00 payable on the day at Registration.
5. **Sailing Instructions** – This event will be run under the current version of the Racing Rules of Sailing and the MYA SSI's with the IRSA Short Penalty. The Race Officer reserves the right to use Observers drawn from the competitors.
6. **Entry List, Sail Numbers and Frequency Allocation** will be advised beforehand by the event organiser.
7. **Parking** – Parking is available at the club, but specific requirements will be advised on arrival.

7. **Refreshments** – Please bring your own food and drink for the day.
8. **General Info** – The clubhouse will be open with toilet facilities available.
